Rescue workers recovering the ground zero site organized **The Ground Zero Independence Ride** in 2002 to raise money to aid victims' families. The charitable ride is a way to reunite, remember and restore hope to people working to overcome life's challenges.

In its seventh year, the all-volunteer effort has become an annual tradition with all proceeds directly benefiting two non-profit organizations, Tuesday's Children and Anderson House.



Tuesday's Children is a family service organization that has made a long-term commitment to every family that lost a loved one on 9-11, providing a wide range of programming including mentoring, educational and career guidance, leadership training and life management programs.
